## WHAT DOES AIG RETIREMENT SERVICES DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and Medical Information
- · Income and Credit History
- Payment History and Employment Information

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. How does AIG Retirement Services protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We restrict access to employees, representatives, agents, or selected third parties who have been trained to handle nonpublic personal information.

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  • Our affiliates include the member companies of American International Group, Inc.	
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  • AIG Retirement Services does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.	
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  • AIG Retirement Services does not jointly market.
